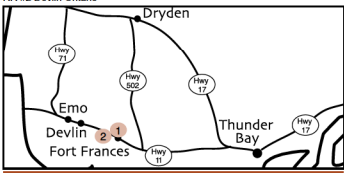

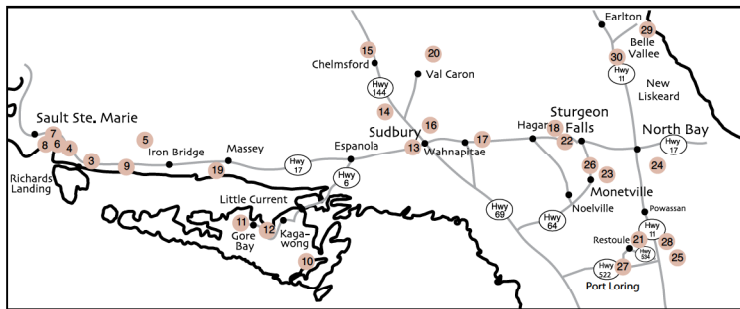

We use a wood fired evaporator and gravity filtering. Syrup is available all year at the farm. To get to our farm: follow Hwy 11 north to Powassan – exit #316 at Hwy 534 – left at the Absace Road to Hemlock Road – turn right at Schlosser Line – first farm on the left. From Hwy 11 north to Trout Creek – exit #306 at Hemlock Road – follow signs to Schlosser Line – turn left on Schlosser Line – first farm on the left. RR #1 #3 Schlosser Line. Trout Creek ON

Belle Vallee Woods produces woven wool blankets in Traditional Tartan and Classic Country patterns (which include checks, tweeds and stripes in coloured and natural (undyed) shades) from yarns produced at the mill. Each blanket is hand inspected, preshrunk and machine washable. Jackets, vests, hand items, knitting yarns and other craft materials are available as is a custom wool processing service. Mail order sales and tours of the operation are available. Regular hours are Monday to Saturday from 8 am to 5 pm
