Belle Vallée Wools is a farm-based woollen mill and the only fully integrated operation of its kind in Canada. The Wight family has been raising sheep and producing wool in Ontario since 1856. Belle Vallée Wools produces woven wool blankets in Traditional Tartan and Classic Country patterns (which include checks, tweeds, and stripes in coloured and natural (undyed) shades) from yarns produced at the mill. Each blanket is hand inspected, preshrunk, and machine washable.

Jackets, vests, handknit items, knitting yarns, and other craft materials are available as is a custom wool processing service. Mail order sales and tours of the operation are available. Regular hours are Monday to Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Located near Belle Vallée, Ontario.
